School Safety:

Occupational Safety Report: The Clerk informed the committee that a report from MSGIA, the District's workers' compensation carrier, showed no claims in the last three years, and minor claims for a few years prior to that; the District has been through several state work place safety inspections by the Department of Labor and Industry, and were able to rectify any issues immediately; overall, the District makes safety of staff a priority.

Other: The committee discussed other areas where there may need improvements, including, but not limited to, the following: the sidewalk between the high school and CB Murray tends to have ice on it due to the drainage and runoff from the roof; the playground has a low spot where a large ice patch forms every year; there isn't a staff lounge, and staff don't really tend to take care of themselves very well; Reflex Protect will need to be replaced in the next year; the staff received more training before school started, but training substitutes on the Reflex Protect product is a good idea; the District's health insurance carrier does offer a wellness program that we may want to take part in.
