Daily homework assignments will not be accepted late. Projects and papers will lose 20% each day they are late.

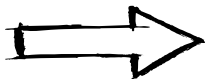
Each month, the school recognizes an outstanding student from each grade level. I will nominate students based on character, leadership, attitude, and academic excellence.
